KEYSTONE is a research project funded by the European Commission's Erasmus+ programme. It works in five EU countries: Greece, Italy, Portugal, Spain and the UK. It's managed by Arcola Research, London.

It's main objective is to run a 'Collaborative Support' programme to provide spaces – in 'Community Labs' – that allow young people 'on the margins' to express their creativity and learn new skills. These Community Labs aim to give a voice to young people who are normally not listened to. They organise activities aimed at helping young people solve issues and problems in their community.
